Reflection

Peace be with you

When Jesus appears in the midst of the disciples, his first words to them are, 'Peace be with you!' His appearance among them obviously agitated the disciples who were already hiding, in fear of their lives and devastated by the loss of their leader days earlier.

Love is the opposite of fear. Love is always letting go of a fear. In the world of modern psychologizing, we have become very proficient at justifying our fears and avoiding simple love. The world will always teach us fear. Jesus will always command us to love.

Today most humans feel that God's love and attention must be earned. Most people are still into fearing God and controlling God instead of loving God. We never fully know that mutual love is possible. We view the power equation as God having all the power—when that is our definition of God—all you can do is fear and try to control.

The only way fear can be dispelled is for God, from God's side, to change the power equation and invite us into a world of mutuality and vulnerability. Our living image of that power change is called Jesus! In him, God took the initiative to overcome our fear and our need to manipulate God and made honest divine relationship possible.

Jesus' calming and reassuring words, 'Peace be with you!' recognise the reality of what state the disciples are in. The words demonstrate that Jesus is meeting the disciples 'where they are' – he recognises their distress and fear and responds with words that accept what they're feeling but reassure them of his love and care. They are words that Jesus speaks to us too!



Let us cast ourselves without hesitation into his Heart. He will not let us perish.


