## Stewardship

#### An experience of God's Mercy

Jesus comes to offer the disciples peace and the restoration of their relationship with Him. But even more, He commissions them to become ministers of His mercy, by giving them the authority to forgive sins.

Today is an opportune time to examine how generously we offer the gift of mercy to those around us. When Thomas obstinately declared he would not believe in the risen. Christ unless he could see for himself the mark of the nails in His hands and put his fingers into those nail marks and put his hands into His side, our Lord does not become indignant. He offers mercy. Jesus graciously gives Thomas the very thing Thomas is asking for — a real and personal encounter with Him, the chance to literally touch His sacred wounds to heal Thomas from his doubts.
