Reflection

Remembered by God

Memory is powerful. It is often one of the last faculties to go in the human brain. It can be so strong that decades after an event people can recall an experience as though it were yesterday. This recollection can bring back strong feelings, which makes us laugh at the pleasure or weep over an unhealed hurt.

We all know people who have limited or no memory and some, tragically, who since birth are unable to communicate whatever they can remember. for Christians it doesn't matter if we remember or not, our soul or spirit is that which is alive to God's memory. We are privileged to know that God remembers us.

In today's Gospel the good thief simply asks Jesus to 'remember me'. In response to the criminal's faith, Jesus assures him, 'today you will be with me in paradise'. There is a certainty and immediacy about the response. Jesus does not tell him that sometime in the future he will be rewarded for his faith. No, it is today that the criminal will join Jesus in paradise. It is an expression of the welcome and inclusion that Jesus has extended to the outsider and undervalued throughout his ministry. It is a clear indication that the Kingdom of God that Jesus has worked to bring about is a kingdom of inclusion and welcome.

Being remembered by God is paradise. It's a wonderful way to understand the Kingship of Christ. We know that Christ our King is not about earthly power, land, buildings, riches or might. We know Jesus' Kingship is not about lording it over us, or making us frightened of his compassionate judgment. The power of Christ the King is seen in his memory, holding every person in this world close; calling each one of us by name.

Eternity

How can we obtain some idea of eternity? Figures are not enough; what are billions and billions of centuries in comparison with eternity that never ends? Someone said, imagine that the world would become an extremely hard diamond globe nine thousand miles in circumference, and that a bird would come once every thousand years touching slightly that diamond with its wing. After an unimaginable number of centuries that enormous diamond would have been worn away by that slight touch, but eternity would have hardly begun. Even if you multiply the number of earths and add a number of suns that are to be touched slightly by the wing of that bird, and you make the time between each visit as long as you want, all stars, however many, however enormous, would disappear like a stone worn away by water, and eternity would be equally far removed from its end, because it will never end.

There simply is no proportion between our calculations and eternity. Forever, eternally..... these words are, like God, a bottomless abyss.


