Reflection

We are called by God

Abraham is called from among the nations to bring God's blessing to the nations. We are called by God, however the one called is free to accept or reject it. But the one who hears God's call and responds is called to trust God to bring it to fulfilment.

A vocation is primarily about the fulfilment of God's purpose rather than personal satisfaction. Following a vocation involves leaving one's familiar and established world for a new and as yet unknown one, the challenge is to obey and trust God as one steps out into the unknown.

God's promise is that when we trust God and embark on our vocation than our lives will be blessed. The blessings promised by God are undeserved gifts from God. They are not earned they are God's gifts of grace. The graciousness of God transforms us in such a way as to effect new beginnings.

Through Christ Jesus we are called to a new life of holiness; we escape the fetters of death and are brought into the freedom of the resurrection. We see it in the gospel, a glimpse into the future glory of Jesus which, through grace, we will be able to share. Lent is a time of new beginnings which find their origin in the abundant blessings of God.

The ultimate blessing of God is Jesus himself. As Abram was called to be the source of blessing for all others, as Peter, James and John were chosen to witness the transfiguration of Jesus, so today we too are invited to look to Jesus for inspiration during this holy season. Paul speaks of the salvation that Jesus brings as having come, not because of any works of righteousness that we might have performed, but because of the grace of God.
