Peace I Leave You

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

25 May 2025

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks words of deep consolation to his disciples. As he prepares to leave them, he assures them not of an easy life, but of a lasting presence—his own Spirit—and a peace unlike any the world can offer.

Yet, these words also prompt a difficult question. Jesus promises peace, but the world has not known peace in any sustained or universal way since his time. Wars continue, conflict persists, and the human family remains divided. For some, especially in the Jewish tradition, this is a reason to question whether Jesus could truly be the promised Messiah. The expectation was that the Messiah would bring about an age of universal peace—and this, they argue, clearly has not come to pass. So what kind of peace does Jesus promise?

The peace Jesus offers is not the absence of external conflict. It is not a political or social utopia imposed from above. Instead, it is a peace that takes root in the heart. It is the inner stillness and courage that comes from knowing we are loved, accompanied, and never abandoned by God. It is the peace of Jesus himself—who, facing betrayal, suffering, and death, remains centred in his mission of love and forgiveness. His peace is not circumstantial; it is relational. It flows from communion with the Father and is given to all who open themselves to that same communion.

We might say that this inner peace is the seed of the wider peace we long for. It is meant to radiate outward, shaping our relationships, our choices, and ultimately our world. The lack of peace in the world, then, is not evidence of Jesus' failure, but of our failure to live in the Spirit he sends us. The peace of Christ does not override our freedom—it invites our participation. It is sown in vulnerability, nourished in prayer, and made visible in lives of mercy and justice.
