In the First Reading, the Prophet Isaiah prophesies that when the Lord comes, "the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf unsealed; then the lame shall leap like a deer."

Jesus fulfils this prophecy in today's Gospel when he tells John's disciples to go back and report what they have seen: the blind see again, the deaf hear, and the lame walk.

We might wonder: after Jesus healed those who were blind, what was the first thing they saw? The sky? A tree? The people around them?

I can imagine that the first thing they saw was Jesus himself—standing before them, looking at them with love—as they opened their eyes and looked upon him for the very first time.

"It has been said that 'a person is enlightened,' not when they get an idea, but when someone looks at them. A person is enlightened when another loves them. The eyes are windows to the heart; they search the person out and have the power to elicit life." (The Impact of God, Ian Matthew)

I would like to share with you an experience of my own encounter with God and others through my senses. Before I joined the MSC, I worked at the Cerebral Palsy Alliance in Sydney. Through the people I worked with, God opened my senses. I realised that previously I had eyes but could not see, had ears but could not hear, and had a heart but did not know how to love. The people I worked with opened my eyes to see ability within disability; they opened my ears to hear a language beyond spoken words; and they opened my heart to love people for who they are and not for who I wanted them to be.

This week, let us deepen our experience of God through our sense of sight. I invite you to take some time each day to look at the world around you. Imagine God delighting in you as you delight in God's creation.


