COLLECTION OF MONEY


The Archdiocese is transitioning to *cashless collection of money*. Recent events have quickened the pace of change. There are two collections at Mass.


- **The First Collection** contributes to the clergy of the Archdiocese. They receive a set, modest 'stipend' and 'living allowance' for their ministry.
