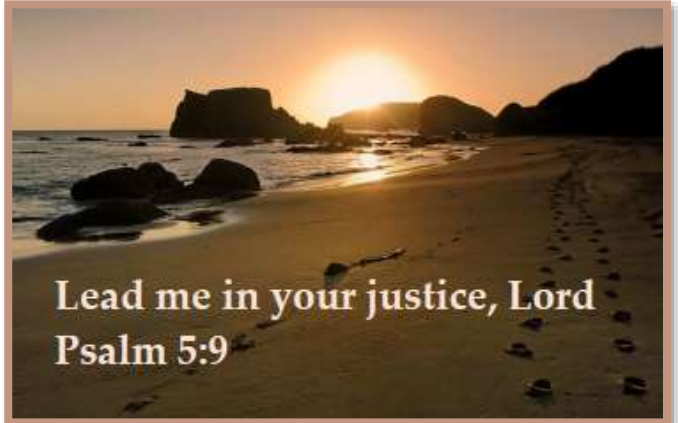
Today is the final production of KIT in a daily format. KIT will now become a monthly production and be sent out at the end of each month. The July KIT will be sent out on 31 July.
